Apart from providing the regular religious services, including baptisms, weddings, and funerals, the Community aspect of the Parish includes a thriving ESL (English as a Second Language, supporting conversational English classes on Fridays for migrants and others), the St Jimmy's Choir, Coffee and Friends on Wednesday mornings, men's dinners, and bible study groups.

With a growing number of families in the immediate area, the church has just appointed a part time Children's and Family Minister.
