



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Wallarah 2 Coal Project (SSD 4974) Wyong Shire Local Government Area

The Honourable Brad Hazzard MP, Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, pursuant to Section 23D of the NSW *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, has directed the Planning Assessment Commission to review the proposed Wallarah 2 Coal Project, and hold a public hearing during the review.

The Commission comprises:

- Mr Garry West.

The terms of reference for the Commission are:

- a) consider the Planning and Infrastructure's (P&I) assessment report of the merits of the project;
- b) consider the EIS for the project, the issues raised in submissions, the formal response to submissions and any other relevant information provided on the project during the course of the review;
- c) assess the merits of the project as a whole, paying particular attention to potential water and biodiversity impacts of the project; and
- d) recommend any further measures required to avoid, minimise, and/or manage the potential water and impacts of the project.
