**The Commitment given to the people of Wyong and the Central Coast is that**

“ The Wyong Areas Coal Joint Venture, the owner of the project, will propose only a mine plan that safeguards the region's surface and sub-surface water regimes from impacts of mining. ”

The Commitment also reads:

- ▶ The project will conduct its business in a manner that at all times respects the people of the Wyong community.
- ▶ The project considers the protection of the environment as an important part of its normal business activities.
- ▶ The project will conduct its business in a way that maintains a safe and healthy workplace for employees, visitors and the local community.
- ▶ The project will develop and implement stringent environmental management practices and will establish enduring programs that will contribute to the interests of the wider community both now and in the future.

This commitment will mean that the amount of coal that could be extracted will be restricted. The balance of social, environmental and economic factors represented by the proposed project will ensure that a truly viable project can be developed in the Wyong region.
